RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SUPPORT OF NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK, MAY 18th-24th, 2025

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, Section 21 of the Port Act authorizes the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) to pass all necessary ordinances and resolutions for the regulation of the District; and

WHEREAS, since 1960, the American Public Works Association (APWA) has sponsored National Public Works Week (NPWW); and

WHEREAS, NPWW is a celebration of the tens of thousands of men and women in North America whose work focuses on infrastructure, facilities and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and well-being of the people; and

WHEREAS, across the nation, NPWW pays tribute to our public works professionals, engineers, managers, and employees; and recognizes the substantial contributions they make to protecting our national health, safety, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to show its support for the APWA which has selected "People, Purpose, Presence" as its theme for 2025's NPWW, which will be celebrated May 18-24, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the "People, Purpose, Presence" encapsulates the qualities that public works professionals bring to their jobs every day; and

WHEREAS, this week seeks to increase public awareness of the contributions as well as to enlighten the public about the duties, practices, and goals of public works professionals; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the BPC adopt a resolution in support of National Public Works Week.
