AGREEMENT NO. 47-2021SN**

The parties to this Amendment No. 1 to Agreement are the SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT, a public corporation (District) and GLENN A. RICK ENGINEERING & DEVELOPMENT COMPANY DBA RICK ENGINEERING COMPANY, a California Corporation (Design Professional).

Recitals:

District and Design Professional are parties to an Agreement for As-Needed Civil Engineering Services. The Agreement is on file in the Office of the District Clerk as Document No. 73404 dated December 15, 2021. It is now proposed extend the term of the Agreement and to increase the Agreement amount by \$3,000,000.00 from a total of \$4,000,000.00 to a new total not to exceed \$7,000,000.00.

The Parties Agree:

1. The **TERM OF AGREEMENT**, Section 2, is hereby extended to December 31, 2027, subject to earlier termination as provided in the Agreement.
2. Section 3.a., **Maximum Expenditure**, is hereby amended to increase the maximum expenditure under the Agreement by \$3,000,000.00 from a total of \$4,000,000.00 to a new, not to exceed, total amount of \$7,000,000.00.

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3. All other Agreement terms, covenants, and conditions shall remain in full force and effect and shall be applicable to this Amendment.
